TERMS, CONDITION AND RESTRICTIONS THAT APPLY TO THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT AND THE WORK TO BE DONE

This permit is signed by the Lawrence Township Trustees under authority of resolutions heretofore adopted by the Board of Lawrence Township Trustees and no work shall be undertaken by the applicant except such work as the Lawrence Township Board of Trustees has authority to issue a permit for as found in House Bill No. 576, Amended and effective August 16, 1955 which is to enact sections 5571.16 and 5571.99 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

The Board of Lawrence Township Trustees, HEREBY require any person, firm or company to obtain a permit before making any excavation in a public road or highway within their jurisdiction of Lawrence Township. The board, as a condition to the granting of this permit REQUIRES, The APPLICANT SIGNING THIS APPLICATION, THAT THEY AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:—

1. That the applicant will submit a complete plan indicating the location, size, type and duration of the excavating contemplated.
2. That the applicant as well as his contractor shall together be responsible for restoring the road or highway and the right of way to as good a condition as originally found and repair and replace any and all roadway structures without cost to the Lawrence Township Trustees. All debris is to be removed back to lot lines. Drainage is to be effective and workable.

(Specifications for your specific operation are detailed on the face of this application.)

In event conditions are not restored promptly and as required, the applicants certified deposit shall be forfeited at the direction of the Trustees.

3. The applicant and/or contractor shall protect traffic at all times during the progress of the work, and will use proper barricades, signs, lights so as to protect and provide safety for the general public.
4. The applicant and his contractor will at all times provide and maintain suitable driveways to and from abutting properties.
5. The applicant and his contractor also will backfill all excavations with materials suitable to and in a manner satisfactory to the Board of Lawrence Township Trustees.
6. The applicant and his contractor also agree to save Lawrence Township and the Trustees free and harmless from any and all claims for damages to persons or property which might arise as a result of this work.

No person shall make an excavation in any township highway in violation of any resolution adopted pursuant to section 5571.16; except that, in the case of an emergency requiring immediate action to protect public health, safety, and welfare, an excavation may be made without first obtaining a permit, if such application is made at the earliest possible opportunity.

Section 5571.99. Whoever violates section 5571.16 of the Revised Code shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or imprisoned not more than thirty days (30), or both.

NOTICE:— Contractors and applicant must notify Fire Dept. of road being closed in the district of which work is being done.
