The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ackerman. All Trustees were present. The minutes of the last meeting were approved. The following bills were presented for approval.

The above bills were approved by the Board and checks were written. Motion by Haueter and seconded by Ritterbeck to approve Resolution 14-17 participating in the ODOT winter contract and purchasing 550 tons road salt. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, Ackerman yes. Daniel Santilli, Sandra McInteyre, Jason Shaner and several other residents, of Ridge Road, discussed the problems with the Kinder Morgan pipeline trucks using the road and the narrow width of the road causing problems. Residents were also concerned about a residential property could be considered industrial and appears an excavating business is operating on the property. Trustees informed residents they could do nothing about the road use and gave attendees Kinder Morgan contact information to discuss their concerns with them. Also trustees said they were working on the property with the equipment on it. Trustees approved the Bolivar Baseball Association use of township property to place a container for collection of scrap only to raise money. The Board then discussed Township affairs in general and a motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
