

Thursday August 31, 2017

The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ackerman. All Trustees were present except Ritterbeck. The minutes of the last meeting were approved. The following bills were presented for approval.

The above bills were approved by the Board and checks were written. Motion by Haueter and seconded by Ackerman to approve Resolution 18-17 accepting the rates and amounts as determined by the budget commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the county auditor. Roll call, Ritterbeck absent, Haueter yes, and Ackerman yes. Motion by Ackerman and seconded by Haueter to approve Resolution 19-17 requesting the county auditor refrain from collecting on the three old continuing fire levies until such time as the Trustees inform the auditor to start collection on them. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck absent and Ackerman yes. Motion by Haueter and seconded by Ackerman to correct the Minutes from May 12, 2016 where Resolution 15-16 referring to Zoning Resolution 16-01 should have been 16-02. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck absent and Ackerman yes. Motion by Ackerman and seconded by Haueter to approve the hiring of Paul Lackey, as seasonal help, at \$9.50 per hour. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck absent and Ackerman yes. Motion by Haueter and seconded by Ackerman to pay \$3,500 for more riprap for the detention pond. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck absent and Ackerman yes. Marcine Mauger asked if their put their mother’s farm on Zutavern Church Road into a trust would they still qualify for the CAUV taxes on the farm. Trustees believed so, but told her to discuss with the county auditor. Mauger also inquired about putting a granny suite on her mother’s property. Zoning Inspector Weekley told them to come into his office in the morning and he will discuss the particulars. Weekly also informed them that as far as water and septic the health department would have to decide that. Tedd Finlayson inquired about the Fire Prevention Officer and trustees said would look into. Trustees agreed to let the health department use the township as a drop off point for tires as long as no cost to the township. The Board then discussed Township affairs in general and a motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
