

Thursday December 8, 2016

The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ackerman. All Trustees were present. The minutes of the last meeting were approved. The following bills were presented for approval.

The above bills were approved by the Board and checks were written. Motion by Ackerman and seconded by Haueter approve resolution 31-16 approving \$200,000 temporary appropriations for 2017. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, Ackerman yes. Motion by Ackerman and seconded by Haueter to approve resolution 32-16 increasing appropriations \$8,800 in general fund, \$5,300 in cemetery fund, \$12,000 in Lodging tax fund and \$5,000 in fund for sale of fixed assets. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck yes and Ackerman yes. Motion by Ritterbeck and seconded by Ackerman to purchase current copier for \$1,654.44 and enter a maintenance agreement thru 2020. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck yes and Ackerman yes. Motion by Ritterbeck and seconded by Haueter to pay \$6,600 for detention pond access under railroad tracks. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck yes and Ackerman yes. Motion by Haueter and seconded by Ackerman to sign contract with Wheeling Lake Erie railroad for detention pond crossing after reviewed by legal counsel. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck yes and Ackerman yes. Zoning Commission approved resolution 2-16 making revisions to the zoning book. Trustees will hold a public hearing 12-29-16 at 6:30pm before approving the zoning revisions. Trustees will hold their reorganization meeting 12-29-16. Kim Beans, Tusc. Cty. Office of Community Economic Development, gave trustees pamphlets on the Fair Housing Guide. Trustees discussed the guide and will have pamphlets at the township office. Trustees have had problems with a resident on Eberhart road with leaves on township property and residents on Greenbrier Square with parking and blocking access for the snowplow and will have Sheriff Deputy look into it. The Board then discussed Township affairs in general and a motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
