The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Haueter. All Trustees were present. The minutes of the last meeting were approved. The following bills were presented for approval.

The above bills were approved by the Board and checks were written. Motion by Ritterbeck and seconded by Ackerman to send bill for \$142,539.63 to Kinder Morgan for road damage caused by oil pipeline installation. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, Ackerman yes. Motion by Haueter and seconded by Ritterbeck to post legal notice in newspaper for chip and seal for 2018. Roll call Haueter yes, Ritterbeck yes and Ackerman yes. Motion by Ritterbeck and seconded by Haueter to continue with the curb work on Lawn Ridge at a cost of \$45,625 with Reidl Construction. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, Ackerman yes. Motion by Ritterbeck and seconded by Ackerman to replace grates in shop at a cost of approximately of \$2,000. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, and Ackerman yes. Martha Simon informed trustees she is looking to sell her Banquet Center if trustees know of anyone interested. Simon also asked for signage for business along Boulevard. Trustees also discussed options on composting and what signs to post. The Board then discussed Township affairs in general and a motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
