General discussion about a noise resolution which is listed in the zoning book and Weekley suggested it be removed from the zoning books and replaced with a simpler resolution. Trustees approved Canal Lands adoption program agreement. Trustee Ritterbeck said Tusc Parks are seeking volunteers, civic organizations private businesses industry, to select a portion of the Canal Lands to keep clean and free of debris.
