Trustees advised Weekley to send the letter. Road Superintendent McNutt advised trustees that the chip & seal legal notice has been put in the Times Reporter with a deadline of Tuesday, May 28, 2020. Signs have been installed at the basketball courts to practice social distancing. Trustees want to leave the courts open with proper social distancing, but if the trash continues to be an issue the courts will be closed. Township is still taking applications for summer help. Trustees want to advise the township residents that even though the festivities for Memorial Day have unfortunately been cancelled, the cemetery is still open to remember our veterans, please practice social distancing.
