The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ackerman. All Trustees were present.

PUBLIC SPEAKS

Shawn Lynch, Fire Chief, stated the department has received their new radios and they will go live on June 2, 2020. This is a state wide system and fire department has been trained and the system has been tested.

Meeting

Trustees received one bid for the chip and seal project. The bid was from 20/20 Enterprises, Inc. for liquid asphalt supplied, applied and covered with #8 limestone/gravel using MWS90 or equivalent at \$2.70 per gallon. 20/20 Enterprises included a certificate of liability insurance.

Motion by Ritterbeck and seconded by Haueter to accept the bid. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, and Ackerman yes. Martin L. Dreher Inc. provided the trustees with a tax exemption certificate and Chairman Ackerman signed the form. They are doing the curb work for the township. McNutt advised the compost is still open, but with the installation of the new cement people will have to go around the building. McNutt thanked the employees for their dedication in getting the mowing done in the rain for the cemetery for Memorial Day. Chairman Ackerman complimented the workers indicating that the flowers and cemetery looked very nice and hoped that residents were able to visit the cemetery. Chairman Ackerman indicated that it was renewal time for the township insurance and all insured assets are being verified. Ritterbeck advised the board that he sent a letter of recommendation for Erin Wright of The Thrasher Group to participate in the Appalachian Leadership Institute. Haueter indicated that he met with the road dept. & a township resident regarding water issues and it was determined that it was the resident's issue. Ackerman advise that the Census is still going on and how important it is for everyone to complete the census for local funding purposes The Board then discussed Township affairs in general and a motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
