Trustees received paving information from County Engineer, contract was awarded to Superior Paving. **Motion** by Ritterbeck and seconded by Haueter to accept the Superior Paving contract bid of \$101,550.50. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, and Ackerman yes. Weekley advised the trustees Deputy Anderson has all the pictures needed & is sending to prosecutor regarding the Welton property. The property on Ft. Laurens has been resolved. The car wash is being torn down and they are going to rebuild. There have been several food trucks showing up and they are currently required to get a transient vendor permit at a cost of \$75 annually. Weekley will discuss the fee with the Zoning Commission. Resident contacted Weekley about neighbor property and debris in the yard. Weekley will investigate. Sports Complex update: they are in the process of hiring an architect & engineer, they hope to build this fall and be ready to utilize in the spring. Road Superintendent McNutt advised trustees they are doing ditch work and replacing some pipe that is needed. McNutt asked for 2 port-a-johns at the park and trustees agreed. Curbs are being poured and all work should be done shortly. McNutt said contract came in under projections and after gets total costs will see if any funds available for additional work. There were a lot of trees down from the storm, the road crew has been working on. Eberhart Rd. was closed due to a tree down with live wire and the power company will have to take care of it. The cement work on the parking lot is done, thanks to JSWMD for the grant funds. The Board then discussed Township affairs in general and a motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
