Motion by Ritterbeck and seconded by Haueter to approve Resolution 18-20 approving increasing appropriations by \$58,645.25 in the Covid-19 account. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, and Ackerman yes.

Meeting

Ackerman advised the trustees that the Board of Zoning Appeals approved the fence variance at the hearing Aug. 10, 2020. Ackerman also stated that the Township paid their 1/3 share of court costs to move forward with Kinder Morgan. Deputy Manbeck stated he is watching for semi's speeding on Zutavern Church & Ridge Rd and for solicitor's without permits in the township. Trustees received several complaints regarding golf carts in the Wilkshire Hills area, Deputy Manbeck will follow up. Road Superintendent McNutt reported chip & seal is complete but needs more days of sweeping. **Motion** by Ritterbeck and seconded by Haueter to spend \$3,500 for sweeping. Roll call, Ritterbeck yes, Haueter yes, and Ackerman yes. New door locks will be installed, bill will be sent to Sheriff Campbell for half reimbursement. Ritterbeck is looking into Clean Ohio grants for boat ramps & potential purchase of fire department land. Trustees agreed to send a letter to the fire department. The Board then discussed Township affairs in general and a motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
