Minutes of Lawrence Township Trustees

Regular Meeting

July 28,2022

The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ritterbeck. All Trustees were present.

Minutes from the July 14, 2022 regular meeting were approved.

**PUBLIC SPEAKS**

Township resident asked about replacing a culvert at his driveway and Trustees advised it was his responsibility; another resident asked about a car with expired plates parked in his neighbor's driveway, Weekley will look into it and he expressed his desire for the Wilkshire sign to remain as; and Fire Chief Lynch reported the new fire truck should be ready and all training done by the end of August.

**MEETING**

Ritterbeck advised of potential Scrap Tire collection at the Township building September 10 from 9-12 or until 3 hoppers provided by Gayle's Recycling are full, sponsored by the Tuscarawas County Health Department from grant funding. Ritterbeck met with architect regarding adding onto building using ARP funds. Ritterbeck thanked the Quillen family for the Sparks of Giving and congratulated the Ohio Historical Society and the Zoar Community Association for the rebuild of Ft. Laurens. McNutt contracted with T. Rowley for tree trimming, roads and road signs were checked, ditch work being completed, started second round of mowing along roadways, asked about potential purchase of lighted signs and will get quotes to Trustees, salt contract is in, street sweeping from chip & seal is scheduled first week of August, reminded Trustees of the need for an additional employee, residents using the trail and basketball courts and access to the river are doing a great job cleaning up when they are done, and employees will be working on landscaping around building. Ackerman asked if high weeds by the Community Business sign can be mowed and reminded residents that they can adopt a portion of the River Community Park Trail to keep it clean. A motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by the Chairman.
