Minutes of Lawrence Township Trustees

Regular Meeting

April 9, 2026

The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Trustee Ackerman. All Trustees were present.

Minutes from the March 26, 2026 meeting were approved.

PUBLIC SPEAKS

Township residents Brenda and Dan Boylan discussed the mining by Kimble on French Hill by their residence, she had sent a letter and received a reply and will keep the Trustees updated. Bolivar Fire Chief Shawn Lynch asked Trustees if data centers were part of the Zoning Regulation and was told no, but the Zoning Commission will be discussing the topic at the next Zoning Commission meeting on Tuesday, April 14, 2026.

RESOLUTION

Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter to approve **Resolution 12-26 Authorizing Participation in the ODOT Road Salt Contracts Awarded in 2026**. Ackerman: yes; Haueter: yes; Ritterbeck: yes. **Motion** passed.

MEETING

Road Superintendent Myers asked Trustees to order 600 tons of salt through the ODOT road salt program. Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter. Ackerman: yes; Haueter: yes; Ritterbeck: yes. **Motion** passed. Myers asked Trustees to approve road sweeping in the spring and after chip & seal. Ackerman made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter to approve road sweeping from Reilly Sweeping not to exceed \$11,000. Ackerman: yes; Haueter: yes; Ritterbeck: yes. **Motion** passed. Myers asked Trustees to approve legal notice for chip & seal bids. Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter to approve legal notice to appear in the Times Reporter April 24, May 1 and May 8 for bids for chip & seal. Ackerman: yes; Haueter: yes; Ritterbeck: yes. **Motion** passed. Myers asked Trustees to approve the addition of Blacksnake and Logan Dr to the chip & seal list adding an additional .6 mile as they will already be at adjoining roads. Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter to approve the additional roads for chip & seal. Ackerman: yes; Haueter: yes; Ritterbeck: yes. **Motion** passed. Trustees discussed Kerns Dr. and Myers advised Trustees they are working on ditching, finished tree cutting, and will start berming chip & seal roads. Zoning Inspector Weekley advised Trustees that the Zoning Commission will meet on Tuesday, April 14, 2026. Trustee Haueter asked Weekley about the house being built on French Hill. Weekley advised that the building appears to have stopped assuming they received the letter from the Township attorney and he will check on status of septic permit. Haueter asked about the trailer on Eberhart and Weekley advised he spoke with Hartzler's and they will make the necessary repairs to be in compliance with zoning. Haueter asked about building on St. Pete and Weekley advised it is now compliant with zoning. Trustee Haueter discussed the Myers, Weekley and other Trustees request from resident Stuhlmiller regarding additional access to his property. Fiscal Officer Ackerman presented Trustees with first quarter Revenue and Appropriations Reports and Haueter made a **motion**, seconded by Ritterbeck to approve the Quarterly Credit Card Report. Ackerman: yes; Haueter: yes; Ritterbeck: yes. **Motion** passed. A motion to adjourn was made and so ordered.
